This will enable HUBER+SUHNER to provide customers with end-to-end solutions for next-generation rail communications from a single source.

In recent years, HUBER+SUHNER and Connected Intelligence have already successfully collaborated on customer projects for rail operators such as Deutsche Bahn in Germany, Brightline and Amtrak in the US, as well as Avanti West Coast, Network Rail and c2c in the UK. Connected Intelligence, based in Woking, UK, has around 45 employees. Following the closing of the transaction, the business will be carved out of Motion Applied and integrated into the Transportation segment of HUBER+SUHNER.

The Connected Intelligence team and their capabilities will make a great addition to HUBER+SUHNER. We look forward to welcoming our new colleagues to the Group."
